H 1518. DOT CONTRACTS. Intro. 6/5/02. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Changes title to *AN ACT TO INCREASE THE INFORMAL BID LIMIT FOR DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS, TO MODIFY THE CURRENT AUTHORIZATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO AWARD DESIGN-BUILD CONTRACTS, AND CONCERNING CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS FOR IRON USED IN DOT PROJECTS.* Rewrites GS 136-28.11 to allow 10 design-build contracts in fiscal 2002-03, and 25 in fiscal years 2003-04, 2004-05, 2006-07, 2007-08, and 2008-09. The Dep't must provide a report each year to the Joint Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee on the number and size of all design-build projects. Amends GS 136-28.7(a) to provide that every construction contract require that all steel and iron (was steel and cement) permanently incorporated into the project be produced in the United States.

H 1518. DOT CONTRACTS. Intro. 6/5/02. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Adds requirement that Dep't of Transportation report to Jt. Legislative Transportation Oversight Comm. on scope and nature of any design-build project in excess of \$100 million and how design-build development of project will serve the public interest. Removes requirement that DOT submit an annual report listing number and size of all design-build projects to Comm.
