H 260. ELECTION LAWS REVISION. TO CREATE THE ELECTION LAWS REVISION

COMMISSION. Creates a 17-member bipartisan Election Laws Revision Commission charged to study elections and recommend a comprehensive revision of North Carolina election laws before the 2003 Session of the General Assembly. Provides for commission member appointments as follows: four each by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House and Governor, each to include at least one designated county official and to be bipartisan; the Chair and Executive Secretary-Director of the State Board Of Elections; and the state chairs of the three political parties whose nominees for Governor received the largest number of votes in the most recent general election. Provides for staffing and per diem expenses, with funding to be provided from funds appropriated to the General Assembly.
