H 274. AMEND JUVENILE JUSTICE TERMINOLOGY. Intro. 2/27/01. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Replaces original bill with AN ACT TO AMEND CERTAIN STATUTORY TERMS AND REFERENCES RELATED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION. Amends GS 7B-1501 and 143B-15 to define a "youth development center" as a secure residential facility providing long-term treatment, education, and rehabilitative services to delinquent juveniles. Directs Revisor of Statutes to substitute the term "youth development center" for the term "training school" wherever it appears in the General Statutes. Makes conforming changes to reflect current organization of the Dep't of Juvenile Justice.
