H 286. COMMUNICABLE DISEASE REPORTING. TO CLARIFY THE APPLICABILITY OF COMMUNICABLE DISEASE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS TO ALL DIAGNOSTIC LABORATORIES. GS 130A-139 requires persons in charge of “clinical or pathological laboratories providing diagnostic service” to make a report to a public health agency when a specimen tests positive for certain communicable diseases. Bill deletes the words “clinical or pathological,” thus making the requirement applicable to all laboratories performing diagnostic services.

Changes title to *AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE APPLICABILITY OF DISEASE REPORTING AND INVESTIGATION REQUIREMENTS TO ALL DIAGNOSTIC LABORATORIES*, and adds amendments to GS 130A-144 and –458 to make it clear those statutes apply to all diagnostic laboratories.
