H 332. ENERGY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM. TO REVISE THE BUSINESS ENERGY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM. Expands energy efficiency technical assistance and loan program within Dept' of Administration to include local governments and nonprofit organizations as customers. Lowers rate on loans from energy revolving loan fund to 3% (was, 5%) and authorizes rules to allow loans for certain projects at rates as low as 1%.
