H 342. ECS RECORDS/EVIDENCE. RELATING TO THE ADMISSIBILITY, PHOTOGRAPHIC REPRODUCTION, AND RETENTION OF RECORDS OF THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY COMMISSION. Adds a new subsection to GS 8-45.3 providing that the Employment Security Comm'n (Comm'n) is authorized to have its records photographed, photocopied, or microphotocopied and that the photographs or copies, when certified by the Comm'n as true and correct, shall be admissible in evidence as the originals. Adds a new subsection to GS 132-3 providing that when a Comm'n record has been copied, the original may be destroyed upon the order of the chairman of the Comm'n. If a record has not been copied, the original shall be preserved for at least three years. Evidentiary provision becomes effective Dec. 1, 2001, and applies to all actions and proceedings pending in the NC courts on or after that date.
