H 374. STATE BOXING COMMISSION. *TO GRANT THE STATE BOXING COMMISSION THE AUTHORITY TO REGULATE WRESTLING AND MIXED MARTIAL ARTS EVENTS, TO AMEND THE LAWS REGULATING BOXING, AND TO ALLOW THE COMMISSION TO INCREASE CERTAIN FEES.* Expands State Boxing Comm'n jurisdiction to cover kickboxing, toughman, wrestling and mixed martial arts events. Requires promoters to provide major medical coverage not to exceed \$2,500 for each fighter. Requires boxers to obtain federal identification cards from the Comm'n. Raises maximum fees for permits to range of \$150 to \$350 (was, \$100 to \$300) based on seating capacity, plus 10% of the total purse for boxing events.

H 374. STATE BOXING COMMISSION. Intro. 3/1/01. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Exempts from license and permit fees any professional wrestling event solely organized, promoted, and managed by staff and volunteers of a 501(c)(3) organization, for which a promoter or manager is not paid. Permits Boxing Commission to adopt temporary rules to implement act. Changes effective date from when the bill becomes law to Jan. 1, 2002.
