H 391. HEALTHY CAROLINIANS FUNDS. *TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ASSIST IN THE ESTABLISHMENT OF HEALTHY CAROLINIAN PARTNERSHIP INITIATIVES IN EACH COUNTY.* Appropriates \$3,750,000 for 2001-02 from the General Fund to the Dep't of Health and Human Services. Of the funds, \$36,000 shall be allocated to each county to establish infrastructure to create or maintain health promotion partnerships to carry out locally defined initiatives inclusive of women and children, youth, work site, minority populations, and aging populations. To receive funds, each county shall ensure that partnerships meet established standards developed by the Governor's Task Force on Health Objectives for Year 2000 and monitored by the Div. of Community Health. Counties shall provide documentation evidencing an in-kind contribution or match of at least 50% of funds received under the section from local partnerships to provide space, equipment, and supplies. Of the funds, the Dep't may use up to \$150,000 to support technical assistance activities. Effective July 1, 2001.
