H 542. NOMINATING UNC BD. OF GOVERNORS. TO ESTABLISH THE PROCEDURE FOR NOMINATING AND ELECTING MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA. Assigns to the House University Board of Governors Nominating Committee the duty to nominate members of UNC Board of Governors and sets forth nominating procedures. Allows each Representative to nominate up to two persons. Nominations must be in writing and submitted to the House principal clerk by 5:00 p.m. on March 29, 2001. An individual may not be nominated in more than one category and is not eligible for nomination if he or she was nominated and not elected to the Board of Governors by the Senate during the 2001 session. Provides that House will elect nine Board members: six at-large members for four-year terms; two persons in the political minority party category for four-year terms; and one person in the minority race category for the remainder of an unexpired term that ends on June 30, 2003. Provides for screening of nominees by the committee with respect to qualifications, experience, opinions, and statutory suitability. Directs committee to present a slate of candidates with no more than twice the number of candidates for the total number of seats open in each category. Requires House to hold its election no later than the beginning of the daily session on April 5, 2001. Sets forth election procedures and voting rules.
