H 547. POSTRETIREMENT EARNINGS. TO AMEND THE LAW GOVERNING POSTRETIREMENT EARNINGS BY RETIREES OF THE TEACHERS' AND STATE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM. Amends GS 135-3(8)(c) to (1) require suspension of benefits if retiree's earnings exceed current statutory limits during the twelve-month period immediately following the date of retirement or in any calendar year after retirement, and (2) provide that postretirement earnings of a beneficiary who has been retired at least six months (now, at least twelve months) and has not been employed in any capacity, except as a substitute teacher, with a public school for at least six months (now, at least twelve months) immediately preceding the effective date or reemployment do not include the beneficiary's earnings as a substitute, interim, or permanent teacher in a public school. Requires local school administrative unit, rather than Department of Public Instruction, to certify to TSERS the reemployment of a retired teacher. Effective July 1, 2001.
