H 56. NC COMPETITION INITIATIVE. ESTABLISHING THE NORTH CAROLINA GOVERNMENT COMPETITION COMMISSION TO PROVIDE FOR BETTER GOVERNMENT IN NORTH CAROLINA THROUGH A COMPREHENSIVE STATE GOVERNMENT COMPETITION INITIATIVE. Adds new chapter 143C creating NC Government Competition Comm'n to be located administratively within Dep't of Commerce, but acting independently of the Sec'y. Charges Comm'n to cause the use of competition to improve delivery of state services and increase efficiency. Comm'n consists of nine members, three each appointed by Governor, Speaker of the House and President Pro Tem of the Senate, with two-thirds of members from the private sector. Authorizes Governor, General Assembly, or Comm'n to require any state agency to perform a "public-private competition analysis" if Comm'n has received a proposal from a private entity for competition. Requires annual reports by Office of State Budget, Planning and Management and the Comm'n to the Governor and the General Assembly.
