H 636. ELIZABETH CITY CHARTER REVISED. Intro. 3/15/01. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Replaces blank bill with bill titled AN ACT TO REVISE AND CONSOLIDATE THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF ELIZABETH CITY AND TO REPEAL PRIOR CHARTER ACTS. Provides for eight person council, with two persons elected by and from each of four wards; provides for two-year terms for all council members. Provides that mayor is elected by voters to two-year term, and that city operates under council-manager system. Provides that vacancies occurring more than 90 days before beginning of filing period for next city election are to be filled by special election and sets out rules for conducting such an election. Provides that city elections are to be held under the nonpartisan election and runoff method. Includes special provisions concerning settlement of claims by city manager, letting of construction or repair contracts of under \$500,000, and authorizing city to regulate speed of vessels in waterways.
