Adds new amendment to GS 20-116(b) (which now provides that no "passenger-type vehicle" may be operated on any highway with a load extending beyond the line of the fenders on the left side or extending more than six inches beyond the line of the fenders on the right) to make that section applicable to recreational vehicles.
