H 806. REFRIGERATION CONTRACTORS AMENDMENT. Intro. 3/26/01. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Completely rewrites bill so it is now entitled *AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE DEFINITION OF REFRIGERATION TRADE OR BUSINESS UNDER THE LAWS RELATING TO REFRIGERATION CONTRACTORS.* Bill now (1) amends GS 87-58 (which currently provides that the laws governing refrigeration trade or business do not apply to "comfort cooling devices or systems") to provide that the laws governing refrigeration trade or business do not apply to "air conditioning units, devices, or systems for the purpose of cooling offices, buildings, houses, works, manufacturing plants, or any machinery, manufactured article, or processing of material;" and (2) adds a new GS 87-58(a1) to provide that the laws governing refrigeration trade or business do not apply to the repair or replacement of parts or components of a refrigeration system provided that the repair or replacement is performed by a licensee under GS 87-21(a)(1) (plumbers) or GS 87-43.3 (electrical contractors).
