H 817. RICHMOND COUNTY SUBDIVISIONS. Intro. 3/27/01. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Replaces blank bill with AN ACT RELATING TO THE DEFINITION OF SUBDIVISION IN RICHMOND COUNTY. Amends GS 153A-335, as it applies to Richmond County only, to define subdivision by three subcategories—family subdivision, minor subdivision, and major subdivision—and to provide that major subdivisions are only ones subject to regulation by ordinance.

H 817. RICHMOND COUNTY SUBDIVISIONS. Intro. 3/27/01. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Rewrites definitions of family subdivision and minor subdivisions. New definition of family subdivision is tract or parcel in which all lots have access to a road, property is conveyed to a lineal descendant, parent, grandparent, sibling, aunt, uncle, niece or nephew, and no more than ten lots are created. Minor subdivision is tract or parcel that does not create more than four lots in a two year period, does not dedicate any new street or extend water or sewer system except to add connections to existing lines to serve individual lots.
