H 819. ROCKINGHAM CHARTER AMENDMENTS. AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF ROCKINGHAM. Provides that two city council members will be elected for four-year terms and one member will be elected for a two-year term beginning in 2003 and that two city council members will be elected for four-year terms and one member will be elected for a two-year term beginning in 2005. In each election the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes will be elected for four-year terms and the candidate receiving the third highest number of votes will be elected for a two-year term. Provides that city finance officer will be appointed by city manager. Makes additional changes regarding time of city council meeting, salary of mayor and city council members, duties of city attorney, and settlement of claims.
