H 823. NONPUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS IN SCHOOL ACTIVITIES. TO PERMIT PRIVATE SCHOOL AND HOME SCHOOL STUDENTS TO ENGAGE IN EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES AT PUBLIC SCHOOLS. Amends GS 115C-47(4) to authorize local boards of education to adopt rules allowing nonpublic school or home school students to participate in public school extracurricular activities that are otherwise unavailable to the students, at the cost of the students' parents and on a space available basis. Applies beginning with the 2001-2002 school year.
