**H 891. REGULATE SPOTLIGHTING OF DEER.** TO REGULATE SPOTLIGHTING OF DEER IN WAKE COUNTY. Makes it a Class 3 misdemeanor to shine a light intentionally upon a deer or to sweep a light in search of deer in Wake County between one-half hour after sunset and one-half hour before sunrise. Act is enforceable by Wildlife Resources Comm'n law enforcement officers, sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and other peace officers with general jurisdiction. Effective Oct. 1, 2001.
