H 893. NO DEER HUNTING WITH DOGS. TO INCLUDE MOORE COUNTY AMONG THOSE COUNTIES IN WHICH DOGS MAY NOT BE USED TO HUNT DEER. Amends GS 113-291.5 to delete Randolph County and to add Moore County to the list of areas in which the Wildlife Resources Commission may regulate the seasons, times, and places within which dogs may be used to take wildlife. Repeals sec. 6.1(c) of SL 1999-301, which provides that it is unlawful to hunt deer with the aid of dogs unless each dog bears a collar, tag, or other identification showing its owner's full name and address, unless the landowner or the landowner's children are hunting deer on the landowner's property.
