**H 957. CHANGE AGE FOR ENTRY INTO PUBLIC SCHOOLS. *TO CHANGE THE MINIMUM AGE FOR ENTRY IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS.*** Amends GS 115C-364 to permit entry of child into public schools if child reached the age of 5 on or before July 1 of that year (was, Oct. 16), or if child did not reach age of 5 by July 1 but has been attending school during that school year in another state in accordance with the laws of that state before moving to North Carolina. Effective July 1, 2001.

**H 957. STUDY AGE FOR ENTRY INTO PUBLIC SCHOOLS.** Intro. 4/3/01. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Changes title to *AN ACT TO STUDY THE MINIMUM AGE FOR ENTRY INTO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS*. Deletes amendment to GS 115C-364 (age of initial entry into public schools). Requires Joint Legislative Oversight Committee to study whether the age of initial entry should be changed. Requires report to 2002 Regular Session.
