H 985. OUT-OF-STATE HANDGUN PERMITS VALID. TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON WHO HAS A VALID CONCEALED HANDGUN PERMIT FROM ANOTHER STATE MAY CARRY A CONCEALED HANDGUN IN COMPLIANCE WITH STATE LAW IN NORTH CAROLINA AND TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO ENTER RECIPROCITY AGREEMENTS WITH ALL STATES THAT RECOGNIZE NORTH CAROLINA'S HANDGUN PERMIT AS VALID. Adds new GS 14-415.24 for purposes indicated in title. Directs the Dep't of Justice to inquire every six months of every state with which no reciprocity agreement exits as to whether a North Carolina resident may carry a concealed handgun in that state based on a North Carolina permit or whether a North Carolina resident may apply for a permit in that state based on having a valid North Carolina permit.
