S 1006. LOCAL HEALTH DIRECTOR APPT./DISCIPLINE. *TO AMEND THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' ROLE IN THE SELECTION AND DISCIPLINE OF A LOCAL HEALTH DIRECTOR.* Under current law, a local board of health must consult with the county commissioners before it appoints a local health director, but it need not obtain their approval of the appointment. Bill requires the county commissioners to approve the appointment of the director. Also authorizes the county commissioners to recommend disciplinary action against the health director, including dismissal.
