**S 1007. STUDY ALTERNATIVE ENERGY SOURCES.** Intro. 4/5/01. Senate committee substitute replaces blank bill. Changes title to *AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE STUDY COMMISSION ON ALTERNATIVE ENERGY SOURCES.* Establishes Study Commission on Alternative Energy Sources, consisting of 20 members, including representatives of utility companies, consumers of electricity, agricultural interests, and the environmental community. Directs the comm'n to examine the availability and use of alternative energy sources in the state, including the use of biomass resources. Requires the comm'n to report its findings and any recommendations to the 2003 General Assembly, at which time the comm'n shall terminate. Of funds appropriated to the General Assembly, the Legislative Services Commission may allocate up to \$25,000 for 2001-2002 and up to \$25,000 for 2002-2003 for comm'n expenses.
