Changes title to *AN ACT TO MAKE IT A CRIMINAL OFFENSE FOR A PRISONER TO THROW BODILY FLUIDS OR EXCREMENT AT A STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE WHILE IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THE EMPLOYEE'S DUTIES.* Rewrites new GS 14-258.4 to provide that any person in the custody of the Dep't of Correction, the Dep't of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, a law enforcement officer, or any local confinement facility, including persons pending trial, appellate review, or presentence diagnostic evaluation, who knowingly and willfully throws, emits, or causes to be used as a projectile, bodily fluids or excrement at a state or local government employee performing official duties is guilty of a Class F felony. Applies to violations committed inside or outside of the prison, jail, detention center, or other confinement facility.
