DEFINING "NEEDY NORTH CAROLINA STUDENTS." *TO AMEND G.S. 116-19 BY DEFINING THE TERMS "NEEDY NORTH CAROLINA STUDENTS" AND "INSTITUTIONAL METHODOLOGY".* For purposes of the State Education Assistance Authority, "needy student" is defined to be a student who has financial need as determined by the institution under the institutional methodology or the federal methodology as defined by the State Education Assistance Authority.
