S 1283. PRESIDENT PRO TEM AND SPEAKER APPOINTMENTS (NEW). Intro. 6/10/02.

Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Replaces original bill with appointments of President Pro Tem and Speaker. Makes changes affecting the organization and procedures of the state Board of Mortuary Science, including selection by appointment (was by election) under GS 90-210.18. Changes the composition of the state Real Estate Commission from nine to eleven members; the state Appraisal Board from seven to nine members; increases to two the appointments upon recommendation of the Speaker and President Pro Tem, respectively on the Structural Pest Control Committee. Revises the appointments to the Clean Water Management Trust Fund Board of Trustees under GS 113-145.5 to provide for staggered terms and makes other technical changes affecting this board. Abolishes the Task Force on School-Based Management by repeal of GS 115C-105.31. Increases the membership of the Joint Select Committee on Information Technology from 16 to 18. Increases the membership of the State Building Comm'n from nine to eleven. Increases membership of the state Wildlife Resources Comm'n from 19 to 21. Amends GS 143B-295 to specify that membership on the Soil and Water Conservation Comm'n is an office that may be held concurrently with another elective or appointive office in addition to the maximum allowed under GS 128-1.1. Increases membership on the state Parks and Recreation Authority from 11 to 13. Abolishes the Governor's Advocacy Council on Children and Youth by repeal of Chapter 143B, Article 17, Part 9. Increases membership on the Economic Development Board from 37 to 38. Amends GS 158-8.2(b) to specify that any local official (was, county commissioner) appointed to the North Carolina Regional Economic Development Commission may hold that office in addition to the offices permitted in GS 128-1.1.

S 1283. PRESIDENT PRO TEM AND SPEAKER APPOINTMENTS. Intro. 6/10/02. Senate amendments make the following changes to 1st edition. Amendment #1 adds two appointments; increases the membership of the Clean Water Management Trust Board of Trustees from 18 to 21, and makes conforming changes; deletes changes to the Soil and Water Conservation Commission statute that would have allowed the office to be held concurrently with others for dual office-holding purposes; adds a new provision increasing the membership on the Auctioneers Commission from five to seven; and increases the membership on the Board of Electrolysis Examiners from three to five. Amendment #2 deletes provision that abolished the Governor's Advocacy Council on Children and Youth. Amendment #3 deletes changes affecting the Board of Mortuary Science.

S 1283. PRESIDENT PRO TEM AND SPEAKER APPOINTMENTS. Intro. 6/10/02. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 4th edition. Eliminates several appointments of the Senate Pres. Pro Tem. Adds appointments of the Speaker of the House. Increases membership of NC Board of Mortuary Science from 9 to 12 and reconstitutes membership, effective July 1, 2003. Reconstitutes membership of Clean Water Management Trust Fund. Increases non-voting membership of the Global TransPark Development Comm'n from 4 to 10 and provides for appointment of new members. Increases membership of the Private Protective Services Board from 14 to 16 members and provides for appointment of new members.
