S 148. LAW OFFICERS MEMORIAL SIGNS. Intro. 2/15/01. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Adds provisions that signs are to be erected upon request, that signs are authorized when the officer has died in a highway-related enforcement action, and that the requesting family or organization shall reimburse the state for the cost of the sign and its installation.
