S 264. REQUIRE STATE REPORTS DOUBLE-SIDED. TO REQUIRE STATE REPORTS TO BE PRINTED ON BOTH SIDES OF THE PAPER. Amends GS 130A-309.14(j) to eliminate practicability exception to requirement that state agency, legislative, judicial, and university reports be printed on both sides of the paper. Effective July 1, 2001.

S 264. REQUIRE STATE REPORTS DOUBLE-SIDED. Intro. 2/27/01. House amendment makes the following changes to 1st edition. Provides that state report must be printed on both sides of the paper if no additional time and staff would be required to fulfill this requirement (underlined words added). Adds provision that state publications of historical and enduring value and importance to NC citizens must be printed on alkaline (acid-free) paper pursuant to GS 125-11.13.

Amends amendment adopted on 5/15/01 to specify that requirement that state agency reports be printed on both sides of paper applies only if no additional time, staff, equipment, or expense required to do so.
