S 439. CHARLOTTE-PARKING ORDINANCES. TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE TO ADOPT AND ENFORCE ORDINANCES RELATING TO PARKING. Authorizes city council to adopt ordinances relating to use of wheel locks on illegally parked vehicles on which there are three or more outstanding, unpaid parking tickets, and relating to parking in spaces for handicapped persons, near fire hydrants and fire station driveways, near public or private driveways, and near intersections or crosswalks. Violation of parking ordinances is not an infraction or misdemeanor. Allows enforcement of parking ordinances by persons authorized in ordinance and by city manager as well as law enforcement officers. Repeals other provisions regarding fire safety parking regulations.
