S 441. STATE SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT APPOINTED. *TO MAKE THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION AN APPOINTEE OF THE GOVERNOR AND TO MAKE CORRESPONDING STATUTORY CHANGES.* Amends North Carolina Constitution so that Superintendent of Public Instruction is no longer elected by a vote of the people. Provides that Governor appoints Superintendent, subject to confirmation by the General Assembly by joint resolution. Provides that constitutional amendments go into effect only if approved in referendum held on Nov. 5, 2001. Makes conforming statutory changes to GS Ch. 115C, 147, 163.
