Changes title to read, AN ACT TO APPLY A LAW CLOSING A LOOPHOLE IN THE MINIMUM HOUSING STANDARDS ACT AS IT APPLIES TO MUNICIPALITIES LOCATED IN COUNTIES WITH POPULATIONS IN EXCESS OF SEVENTY-ONE THOUSAND PEOPLE BY THE LAST CENSUS WHERE THE OWNER CAN AVOID ORDERS TO REPAIR, REMOVE, OR DEMOLISH A RENTAL UNIT BY SIMPLY CLOSING IT SO THAT IT WILL APPLY IN THE ENTIRETY OF A MUNICIPALITY LOCATED IN MORE THAN ONE COUNTY WHERE SOME OF THE MUNICIPALITY IS LOCATED IN A COUNTY THAT MEETS THE POPULATION THRESHOLD, AND TO ALLOW A CERTAIN TOWN TO EXERCISE PLANNING JURISDICTION OVER A DESCRIBED AREA SUBJECT TO A REFERENDUM. Adds provisions authorizing the Town of Elon to exercise planning powers over a specifically described area, subject to a referendum.
