S 474. NC TOLL ROAD AND BRIDGE AUTHORITY. TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE NORTH CAROLINA BRIDGE AUTHORITY TO THE NORTH CAROLINA TOLL ROAD AND BRIDGE AUTHORITY, TO AUTHORIZE THE AUTHORITY TO CHARGE A TOLL ON A NORTH-SOUTH PRIMARILY RURAL INTERSTATE HIGHWAY, AND TO DIRECT USE OF TOLL PROCEEDS TO EXPANSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THAT INTERSTATE HIGHWAY AND FOR OTHER TRANSPORTATION PURPOSES. As title indicates. Applies to any major north-south interstate route in NC that does not pass through a municipality with a population greater than 250,000 according to the latest decennial census. Interstate highway toll will be levied at discretion of Authority but may not exceed \$10.
