S 474. NC TOLL ROAD AND BRIDGE AUTHORITY. *TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE NORTH CAROLINA BRIDGE AUTHORITY TO THE NORTH CAROLINA TOLL ROAD AND BRIDGE AUTHORITY, TO AUTHORIZE THE AUTHORITY TO CHARGE A TOLL ON A NORTH-SOUTH PRIMARILY RURAL INTERSTATE HIGHWAY, AND TO DIRECT USE OF TOLL PROCEEDS TO EXPANSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THAT INTERSTATE HIGHWAY AND FOR OTHER TRANSPORTATION PURPOSES.* As title indicates. Applies to any major north-south interstate route in NC that does not pass through a municipality with a population greater than 250,000 according to the latest decennial census. Interstate highway toll will be levied at discretion of Authority but may not exceed \$10.
