S 626. DOMESTIC VIOLENCE FATALITY REVIEW TEAM. ESTABLISHING A PILOT PROGRAM TO REVIEW DOMESTIC VIOLENCE FATALITIES. Allows Mecklenburg County and one rural county, to be selected by the Governor's Comm'n on Domestic Violence, to establish a multidisciplinary domestic violence fatality review team to identify and review domestic violence related deaths and to facilitate communication among various domestic violence agencies to prevent future deaths. The local board of county comm'rs is to appoint lead agency and the lead agency will appoint the Review Team from groups identified in bill. Each team member is responsible for reviewing domestic violence fatalities of victims who were 18 or older. Team also is required to identify areas where local government and other local agencies may increase victim safety and public awareness, and provide training and education for the public in domestic violence related issues. Pilots to operate for 5 years. Each must file an interim report to the Governor's Comm'n on Domestic Violence by June 15, 2003, and make a final report with recommendations by June 15, 2006.
