**S 667. SERVE CRIM. PROCESS/CARTERET CO. GOV'T. COMPLEX.** TO PROVIDE THAT MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS HAVE CONDITIONAL AUTHORITY TO SERVE CRIMINAL PROCESS IN THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT COMPLEX ONLY IN CARTERET COUNTY. Amends GS 15A-301(c) as it applies to Carteret County only to provide that a municipal law enforcement officer may serve criminal process in the county government complex if the officer otherwise has territorial jurisdiction to serve criminal process in a municipality located in that county. Applies only for service of criminal process and does not affect powers of arrest. Includes the county courthouse, magistrates' office, jail, and property within 50 feet of these facilities.
