S 811. PARENT OF SUSPENDED STUDENT/ADEQUATE NOTICE. *TO ENSURE THAT THE PARENTS OR GUARDIANS OF STUDENTS WHO ARE SUSPENDED OR EXPELLED FROM SCHOOL RECEIVE NOTICE THAT IS EASY TO UNDERSTAND.* Amends GS 115C-392 to require that notice of disciplinary measures sent to parents of disciplined student be written in language that is plain and easy to understand. Directs that if English is the parents' second language, the notice must be written both in English and in the parents' first language, and the notice in both languages must be plain and easy to understand. Effective July 1, 2001.

S 811. PARENT OF SUSPENDED STUDENT/ADEQUATE NOTICE. Intro. 4/3/01. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Rewrites bill to amend GS 115C-391 by adding a new subsection (d4) to provide that when student is suspended for more than 10 days, local board is to give notice to student's parent or guardian in both English and the person's first language, if the appropriate foreign language resources are available. Effective July 1, 2001, for disciplinary actions begun on or after that date.
