S 825. STATE HEALTH PLAN CONTRACT/EXEMPT APA. Intro. 4/3/01. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Replaces original bill with AN ACT TO EXEMPT FROM THE CONTESTED CASE PROVISIONS OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT CONTRACT DISPUTES BETWEEN THE TEACHERS' AND STATE EMPLOYEES' COMPREHENSIVE MAJOR MEDICAL PLAN AND ENTITIES UNDER CONTRACT WITH THE PLAN; AND TO CLARIFY THAT A STATE AGENCY MAY SEEK RELIEF UNDER THE DECLARATORY JUDGMENT ACT. Amends GS 150B-1(e) and adds new GS 135-39.11 to provide that dispute involving performance, terms, and conditions of a contract between the Medical Plan and contractors is not a contested case. Amends GS 1-265 to include state agencies within definition of "person" under Declaratory Judgment Act.
