**S 827. REMOVE LUST SUNSET/LAND-USE RESTRICTIONS.** *TO REPEAL THE SUNSET FOR CERTAIN PROVISIONS REGARDING CLEANUPS OF PETROLEUM FROM LEAKING UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS.* SL 2000-51 amended GS 143B-279.9 to provide that land-use restrictions imposed to reduce danger to public health at contaminated sites do not apply to cleanups of petroleum from leaking underground storage tanks. That amendment expires Sept. 1, 2001. This bill removes the sunset clause. Effective Aug. 31, 2001.

**S 827. EXTEND SUNSET LUST LAND-USE RESTRICTIONS.** Intro. 4/3/01. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Changes title to *AN ACT TO DELAY THE SUNSET OF THE EXEMPTION OF CLEANUPS OF PETROLEUM FROM LEAKING UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS FROM CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS RELATED TO LAND-USE RESTRICTIONS AND DEED RECORDATION.* Original bill repealed the cited sunset; the committee substitute instead extends it from Sept. 1, 2001 to Sept. 1, 2002.
