S 854. STATE NATURE AND HISTORIC PRESERVE. *TO CODIFY THE JOINT RESOLUTION ACCEPTING PROPERTIES AS PART OF THE STATE NATURE AND HISTORIC PRESERVE; TO REMOVE CERTAIN LANDS FROM THE STATE NATURE AND HISTORIC PRESERVE; TO CODIFY THESE REMOVALS; AND TO DELETE CERTAIN LANDS FROM THE STATE PARKS SYSTEM.* Deletes four described tracts, each smaller than 1 acre, from State Nature and Historic Preserve; one tract is in Bushy Lake State Natural Area, and three tracts are in Jockey's Ridge State Park. Rewrites GS 143-260.10, which describes areas within State Nature and Historic Preserve, making following changes: (1) makes all references as of April 3, 2001 (now, April 6, 1999); (2) adds all lands within Bullhead Mountain State Natural Area, Eno River State Park, Gorges State Park, and Lake Normal State Park to the preserve; (3) deletes lands with Duke Power State Park from the preserve; (4) provides that tracts excluded from the preserve in Umstead State Park, Crowders Mountain State Park, and Bushy Mountain State Natural Area are deleted from the State Parks System; (5) provides that the tract excluded from Crowders Mountain State Park (and described in section) may be exchanged only for other land for expansion of the park or sold and the proceeds used for such expansion and may not otherwise be sold or exchanged; and (6) deletes described tract in Stone Mountain State Park from preserve.

S 854. STATE NATURE AND HISTORIC PRESERVE. Intro. 4/401. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Rewrites title to read: *AN ACT TO CODIFY THE JOINT RESOLUTION ACCEPTING PROPERTIES AS PART OF THE STATE NATURE AND HISTORIC PRESERVE, TO REMOVE CERTAIN LANDS FROM THE STATE NATURE AND HISTORIC PRESERVE, TO CODIFY THESE REMOVALS, TO DELETE CERTAIN LANDS FROM THE STATE PARKS SYSTEM, AND TO PROVIDE THAT A TECHNICAL AMENDMENT TO THE STATE CONSTITUTION RELATING TO ACCEPTANCE AND DEDICATION OF PROPERTY INTO THE STATE NATURE AND HISTORIC PRESERVE SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO A VOTE OF THE PEOPLE AT THE NEXT STATEWIDE PRIMARY ELECTION.* Adds provision amending SL 1999-268 to provide that constitutional amendment submitted to vote of people by that bill is to be at next statewide primary election instead of at next election in which another constitutional amendment is to be voted on. Amendment is to Sec. 5 of Art. XIV of state constitution and it provides that property may be included in State Nature and Historic Preserve upon passing of a bill to that effect by the General Assembly (instead of a resolution, as the constitution currently requires).
