S 865. PITT VOTING PILOT PROGRAM. TO ESTABLISH A PILOT PROGRAM IN PITT COUNTY TO PERMIT ANY VOTER TO VOTE AT ANY VOTING PLACE. Permits the Pitt County board of elections to establish a pilot program that permits any voter to vote at any voting place open during the election. Such a program must meet a set of standards set out in the bill and be approved by the state board of elections. Before the program can be applied in city elections, the council of that city must agree to participate in the program. The act expires on the day the 2003 General Assembly convenes.
