**S 938. DATE RAPE/AMEND RAPE & DRUG LAWS.** *TO CLARIFY THAT A PERSON WHO IMPAIRS A VICTIM BY ADMINISTERING AN INTOXICANT, DRUG, DESIGNER DRUG, OR OTHER SUBSTANCE TO THE VICTIM WITHOUT THE VICTIM'S KNOWLEDGE AND THEN ENGAGES IN A SEX ACT WITH THE VICTIM IS GUILTY OF SECOND DEGREE RAPE OR SEXUAL OFFENSE AND TO PROVIDE THAT IT IS UNLAWFUL TO POSSESS, MANUFACTURE, OR DISTRIBUTE DESIGNER DRUGS.* Amends GS 14-27.3 (second degree rape) and 14-27.5 (second-degree sexual offense) as title indicates. Amends GS 90-87 to define "designer drug" and adds GS 90-94.1 to make unlawful manufacture, distribution, possession with intent to distribute, or possession of designer drugs. Effective Dec. 1, 2001.

**S 938. STUDY DATE RAPE DRUG ANALOGUES.** Intro. 4/5/01. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Changes title to *AN ACT TO DIRECT THE COMMISSION FOR MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES TO STUDY DATE RAPE ANALOGUES AND DETERMINE WHETHER THOSE SHOULD BE INCLUDED IN THE SCHEDULES OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.* Deletes provisions of previous bill and replaces them with provisions requiring a study, as title indicates.

**S 938. STUDY DATE RAPE DRUG ANALOGUES.** Intro. 4/5/01. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Requires Comm'n for Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services to submit its findings and recommendations to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services no later than May 1, 2002.
