**S 968. UNC NONAPPROPRIATED CAPITAL PROJECTS. TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION AND THE FINANCING, WITHOUT APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND, OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS OF THE CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA.** As title indicates. Authorizes the Director of the Budget to increase or decrease the cost of a project or change its method of funding. Allows the Board of Governors, subject to the approval of the Director, to issue special obligation bonds to finance these projects. Authorizes the following capital improvement projects:
