H 10. INDEPENDENT GOV'T REVIEW COMM. CREATING THE INDEPENDENT GOVERNMENT REVIEW COMMISSION. Authorizes new Government Review Commission ("Commission") to review all activities of state government, including funding. Authorizes the Governor to organize Commission into eight teams. Each team must include two members of the General Assembly, one employee of the fiscal research staff and three people from the private sector. Requires the Commission to issue a report of its findings, recommendations, and legislative proposals to the 2005 General Assembly, at which time the Commission will terminate.
