Provides immunity from liability for a health care provider or emergency medical care provider who renders medical, dental, or other health care treatment to a person injured by a terrorist incident, unless the person was injured by the provider's gross negligence, wanton conduct, or intentional wrongdoing. Immunity applies only to the extent that the provider's professional liability insurance excludes coverage for treatment rendered during acts of war or terrorist incidents.
