TO REPEAL ONLY THOSE STATUTES WHICH HAVE BEEN DECLARED UNCONSTITUTIONAL BY A STATE OR FEDERAL COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION AND FROM WHICH NO APPEAL HAS BEEN TIMELY PERFECTED OR THE APPEAL HAS BEEN FULLY CONCLUDED ADVERSELY TO THE STATE. Repeals statutes relating to the tenure of appointment for new Court of Appeals judges; the disclosure of spending for material that names political candidates; the statute of limitation for presumptive ownership of abandoned railroad easements; and provisions authorizing the Alcohol Beverage Control Commission to issue permits, without approval at an election, to qualified establishments in Robeson County.
