**H 1102. RECORD CLOSED SESSIONS.** Intro. 4/10/03. House amendment makes the following changes to 2nd edition. (1) amends GS 143-318.10(e) to provide that a public body is not required to make a sound or video-and-sound recording of a closed session if the closed session is required for any of the reasons set out in GS 143-318.11(a)(1), -(a)(6), or -(a)(8); and (2) amends GS 143-318.10(e) to provide that the sound or video-and-sound recordings of a closed session may be withheld from public inspection unless a court determines that the general written account of the closed session is not sufficient to provide a person not in attendance a reasonable understanding of what transpired or determines that the session should not have been closed.
