H 1108. BEER/WINE SHIPPERS PERMITS. *TO AUTHORIZE THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE COMMISSION TO ISSUE BEER AND WINE SHIPPERS PERMITS TO ALLOW THE DIRECT SHIPMENT OF MALT BEVERAGES*

AND WINES TO RESIDENTS OF NORTH CAROLINA. Substantially similar to S 668, introduced April 2, 2003, except that H 1108 sets fee for wine shipper permit at \$100, instead of \$50.

H 1108. WINE SHIPPERS PERMITS (NEW). Intro. 4/10/03. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Deletes provisions authorizing the Alcoholic Beverage Comm'n to issue beer shippers permits. Adds to wine shipper permit provisions the requirement that a wine shipper permittee that ships more than 1,000 cases of wine to North Carolina addresses in a calendar year must appoint at least one wholesaler to offer to sell the products of the wine shipper permittee if the wine shipper permittee is contacted by a wholesaler that wishes to sell the wine shipper's products. Excise taxes on wine under GS 105-113.80(b) shipped directly to consumers by a wine shipper permittee must be paid by the wine shipper permittee. Makes other technical and conforming changes.
