Provides that only the volunteer, the superintendent and other supervisory personnel, parents and guardians of students with whom the volunteer has had contact, and members of the board of education or its attorney may inspect such records, and that records may also be disclosed pursuant to a valid subpoena or court order. Otherwise allows board to disclose records when it is necessary to maintaining the board's integrity or the level or quality of services provided.
