H 1122. GUARDIANSHIP TRAINING REQUIREMENTS. TO ESTABLISH TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR HEARING OFFICERS IN GUARDIANSHIP CASES. Amends GS 35A-1203(a) to provide that no person who is not a licensed attorney shall preside over a guardianship case pursuant to the clerk's judicial power without first being provided training on the law and procedure of such cases by the faculty of the Institute of Government or other appropriate persons, as determined by the Administrative Office of the Courts. Effective Jan. 1, 2004.
