H 1129. 2003 OMNIBUS LABOR LAW CHANGES. TO REVISE SERVICE REQUIREMENTS TO CONFORM WITH RULE 4 OF THE NORTH CAROLINA RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE, AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL AND OTHER CHANGES TO THE WAGE AND HOUR ACT AND THE PRIVATE PROTECTIVE SERVICES ACT. Amends various statutes in Ch. 95 to provide for service to Comm'r of Labor by designated delivery services as title indicates. Amends GS 95-47.2 to provide that applicants for private personnel service licenses shall pay the costs associated with publication of required legal advertisements, and to require that Comm'r determine whether license shall be issued within 60 (was, 30) days from receipt of licensing application, but in no case more than 75 (was, 45) days. Deletes language in 95-47.9(b) concerning process for adopting administrative rules and authorizes Comm'r to promulgate rules to administer act. Amends GS 95-47.9(c)(1) to delete language concerning hearing requirements and replace it with reference to GS Ch. 150B. Adds new subsection requiring that orders of Comm'r that deny, revoke or suspend a license or impose a fine shall be in writing, signed by Comm'r or designee, and shall state grounds upon which decision is based. Makes technical corrections. Effective July 1, 2003.
